

Terms and Conditions – WsM Pride 2020

- Each stall holder will be issued with 4 wristbands only. These will be provided on arrival at the event. Additional wristbands can be purchased at www.wsmpride.co.uk
- Stall holders will have access to the site for setup during these times only:
Friday 17th 12:00 – 20:00, Saturday 18th 07:00 – 10:00 July 2020
- All stalls to be manned at all times.
- Vehicles will have limited access to the site as part of the setup and clear down of the event so all preparations must be made by the stall holder to ensure the safe and practical transportation of goods and display items. All vehicles must be removed from the site outside of the setup hours stated above. Parking is available on the beach for a daily charge.
- Anyone wishing to stay on the site overnight, MUST pre-book with the Business & Community Team Leader.
- Stall holders will adhere to the strict pitch allocation sizes of 3m x 3m. All marquees, gazebos must be securely weighted. Pitches are on tarmac, so pegs are not suitable.
- In the event of the event being cancelled a full refund will be issued. Otherwise, no refunds available.
- Stall holders will ensure no plastic or glass is given out at the event and waste management is completed safely. All waste must be removed from the site at the end of the event.
- No balloons are allowed to be used on the site in any way.
- Water is available to access on site during setup only. Stall holders must make sure they make adequate arrangements should they need to access water.
- All electronic items and any such other that could be of risk of causing a fire, pollution or risk to the public or infrastructure of the event is checked in good time of the event to ensure minimal risks. Please check with the coordinator of any possible risk items to ensure they are compliant with our health and safety policy. All traders required to show evidence of electrical equipment testing on request.
- All caterers to provide appropriate fire extinguishers/blankets and staff or operatives are competent in their use.
- Gas safety cooking appliances and tanks and hoses - Inspection / gas safety certificate for the appliances and pipe work (copy to be available for inspection). All hoses connections made with “crimped” fastenings.
- LPG cylinders - LPG cylinders to be kept outside, secured in the upright position and out of the reach of the general public.
- Petrol generators are NOT ALLOWED on site. Diesel, Gas or Renewal generators are permitted, as long as they are safe to use and not accessible by attendees. Appropriate cordons must be in place. No more than 5 litres of fuel allowed onsite, must be stored securely and dispensed when generator is cool.
- Stall holders looking to carry out any form of hair or body treatments including face painting have liability insurance coverage clearly listed on their submitted insurance documents.
